Whistleblower Policy

November, 2010

Should any person know of, or have a suspicion about, illegal or unethical conduct in connection with the finances or other aspect of the Society for Biopsychosocial Science and Medicine's operations, that person should inform the Executive Director. If the alleged wrongdoing concerns the Executive Director, then the President of the Society for Biopsychosocial Science and Medicine or another officer should be notified instead.

Should the Executive Director or an officer of the Society for Biopsychosocial Science and Medicine receive information regarding alleged illegal or unethical conduct in connection with the finances or other aspect of the Society for Biopsychosocial Science and Medicine's operations, that person shall notify Council, which shall investigate all credible allegations and act accordingly.

There will be no punishment or other retaliation for the reporting of conduct pursuant to this policy. If the person providing the information requests anonymity, this request will be respected to the extent that doing so does not impede any investigation.
